

3-D Leaf Scarf

This pattern is very textured and stretchy! Once you can see the design coming together, You will enjoy “building” these leaves!

Stitches:

DC- Double Crochet

CH- Chain

BPDC- Back Post Double Crochet

FPDC- Front Post Double Crochet

Dec- decrease stitch or crochet 2 together

Stacked DC- Stacked Double crochet

(alternatively, use a CH3)

Alternatively to the i-Cord foundation, you can chain 31 as your set up row

Finished scarf will be made in 2 pieces and stitched together in your preferred method so the leaves match on both sides.

Materials:

Worsted Weight Yarn (Approx. 150 yds makes 2 leaf repeats) this sample scarf has 3 leaves on each side. 3 skeins were used.

I used three, 3oz, 150 yd. local wool worsted weight yarn skeins

Crochet Hook~ 5.5mm

I suggest as you work, to check your stitches by counting them on either side of the leaf pattern every so often. The number should always be equal as the leaf is centered in the pattern.



i-Cord foundation row (31 stitches)

1- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 30

2- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 25, DC 3

3- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 25, DC 3

4- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 12, BPDC 1, FPDC 12, DC 3

5- Turn, Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 9, Dec, [FPDC1, CH1, FPDC1] around same stitch, Dec,

6- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 9, Dec, BPDC1, [BPDC1, CH1, BPDC1], BPDC1, Dec, FPDC9, DC3

7- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 8, Dec, FPDC2, [FPDC1, CH1, FPDC1], FPDC2, Dec, BPDC 8, DC 3

8- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 7, Dec, BPDC 3, [BPDC1, CH1, BPDC1], BPDC 3, Dec, FPDC 7, DC 3

9- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 6, Dec, FPDC 4, [FPDC1, CH1, FPDC1], FPDC 4, Dec, BPDC 6, DC 3

10- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 5, Dec, BPDC 5, [BPDC1, CH1, BPDC1], BPDC 5, Dec, FPDC5, DC 3

11- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 4, Dec, FPDC 6, [FPDC1, CH1, FPDC1], FPDC 6, Dec, BPDC 4, DC 3

12- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 3, Dec, BPDC 7, [BPDC1, CH1, BPDC1], BPDC 7, Dec, FPDC 3, DC 3

13- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 4, FPDC 16, BPDC 4, DC 3

14- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 3, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec, BPDC 12, Dec, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] FPDC 3, DC 3

15- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 4, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec, FPDC 10, Dec, [DPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] BPDC 4, DC 3

16- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 5, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec, BPDC 8, Dec, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] FPDC 5, DC 3

17- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 6, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec, FPDC 6, Dec, [DPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] BPDC 6, DC 3

18- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 7, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec, BPDC 4, Dec, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] FPDC 7, DC 3

19- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 8, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec, FPDC 2, Dec, [DPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] BPDC 8, DC 3

20- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 9, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec2, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] FPDC 9, DC 3

21- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 10, [FPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] Dec1, [DPDC2 on same stitch (Increase)] BPDC 10, DC 3

22- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 25, DC 3

23- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, BPDC 25, DC 3

24- Turn, 1 Stacked DC, DC 2, FPDC 25, DC 3

Repeat Rows 4-24 to add as many leaves to fit your preference. Each repeat of row 4-24 created one leaf. Up to this point, Your piece will be roughly 10" long before blocking at this point.

The sample scarf has 3 of these leaf repeats on each side.

If you want to keep with width of the scarf, but use a smaller sized yarn, add stitches (FPDC or BPDC) on either side of the leaf pattern, equal amounts on each side.
