

Gore Range Hat

2025 Colorado Wild & Woolly Yarn Crawl

Materials:

1 skein Malabrigo worsted (or equivalent)
16" circular needles Size 9
Double pointed needles Size 9
Stitch Marker
Tapestry needle

Stiches Used:

K- Knit
P- Purl
K2tog- Knit 2 Together

Directions:

With size 9 needles, cast on 80 stitches.
Place stitch marker.
Join in the round.
Rows 1-8: *K2, P2* *Repeat to end of round.
Rows 9 and;10: Knit all around.
Row 11: *P1, K3, P1, K3*
Row 12: *K1, P1, K5, P1*
Row 13: *K2, P1, K3, P1, K1*
Row 14: *K3, P1, K1, P1, K2*
Repeat Rows 11-14, 7 more times, for a total of 8 times
(You can do more repeats if you want a slouchier hat.)
Rows 43: knit all around.
Row 44: *K8, K2tog* all around.
Row 45: knit all around.
Row 46: *K7, K2tog* all around.
Row 47: Knit all around.
Row 48: *K6, K2tog* all around
Row 49: knit all around.
Row 50: *K5, K2tog* all around
Row 51: *K4, K2tog* all around. Somewhere through here you can change to Size 9 double pointed needles.
Row 52: *K3, K2tog* all around.
Row 53: *K2, K2tog* all around.
Row 54: *K1, K2tog* all around.
Row 55: K2tog all around.
Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail.

Thread yarn into tapestry needle and go through the remaining stitches on your double points. Draw tightly to close top and work in ends.
